TOTAL SPENDING \$470 million

Casting benefits throughout the economy.

- Sportsmen support more jobs in Nebraska than First Data Resources Inc. in Omaha (8,500 jobs vs. 6,000).
- Annual spending by Nebraska sportsmen is more than the combined revenues of NetShops, First Comp, Lambriar Animal Health Care, and Adesta - the fastest growing companies in the state (\$470 million vs. \$456 million).
- Spending by Nebraska sportsmen is more than the cash receipts from wheat and dairy products (\$470 million vs. \$405 million).
- There are nearly as many Nebraska sportsmen as residents of Lincoln, the second largest city in the state (234,000 vs. 239,000).
