

!!! Stop Ammunition Buyer Registration !!!

AB 2062 would require 1) that buyers of handgun ammunition possess a Handgun Ammunition Buyer Permit issued by the State Department of Justice, 2) that before selling ammunition, retailers must verify with the Department the validity of the buyer's permit for each transaction, 3) that handgun ammunition buyers must make their purchases in person, not by mail order or the Internet, 4) that handgun ammunition not be displayed by retailers in a location where customers can have access to it, thus necessitating that the retailer obtain it from storage upon a potential buyers specific request, 5) that retailers record information about the sale of ammunition to the buyer and send that information to the Department which will keep registration records, 6) that retailers who sell more than one box (50 rounds) of handgun ammunition per month obtain a handgun ammunition sellers permit from the Department, and other related provisions.

AB 2062 is unnecessary and is a burden to lawful dealers and lawful ammunition buyers. Those who would use firearms and ammunition illegally can, and do, easily obtain them from out of state sources or the local underground marketplace. This bill would affect only lawful businesses and individuals. It would have no impact on criminals.

If AB 2062 becomes law, it will not be long before it applies to all ammunition including rifle, shotgun, muzzle loading projectiles and reloading components.
