Optional Add-On Session 1: Export Compliance Program – Is Yours Up to Date?

Export compliance programs are a critical part of every company's export business. Does your business have the right processes and procedures in place to ensure your activities are complying with the export regulations? Over the past few years, there have been several changes to export enforcement regulations particularly in the EAR which could impact your business. This session will outline these regulatory changes and provide detailed information on the key components of an effective export compliance program. This important session will help your company stay in compliance with export regulations so don't miss it!

Optional Add-on Session 2: Voluntary Disclosures under DDTC, BIS and Census

You may have an export violation – what do to next? DDTC, BIS and Census all have regulations regarding voluntary disclosures, and all with different requirements and different perspectives on how violations are viewed. Knowing the ins and outs of filing a voluntary disclosure helps exporters provide the right information and understand how best to handle the potential violation. This is a session you won't want to miss!

Optional Add-On Session 3: How to Prepare for a Firearm and Ammunition Excise Tax (FAET) Audit

Are you prepared for an audit from TTB? Are your FAET forms and records in order? Auditors from the Department of the Treasury, Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) will provide valuable insights on firearm and ammunition excise tax with a focus on how to complete TTB Form 5300.26, Federal Firearms and Ammunition Excise Tax Return. This session will include line-by-line guidance on how to complete the return, calculate tax, and pay quarterly taxes due on the sale or use of firearms and ammunition. The seminar will also review tax exceptions and exemptions, and other matters of compliance. This two-hour seminar will be of value to all manufacturers and importers of firearms and ammunition and is sure to fill up quickly.
